This scheme has now been delivered by the Priority Sewerage Program (PSP) Alliance team.

Agnes Banks was ready for connections in late May 2010 and Londonderry in December 2010. We are pleased to note that as of 7th November 2011, 230 out of the 256 eligible properties have been successfully connected to the scheme.

System design was by MWH consultants; construction was subcontracted and supervised by John Holland Group and United Group Infrastructure staff. The scheme was delivered ahead of time and under budget.

All discharge flows from the scheme are transferred by the on property Mono SMART pressure sewer systems to two existing pumping stations in nearby Richmond for final transfer to the local Sewerage Treatment Plant.

Based on the successful operation of the equipment, NOV Mono was able to win a further contract to supply 550 units to the Appin sewerage scheme, which is currently under construction and is expected to be fully operational by mid-2012. Further cost savings have been recognised by the PSP Alliance team during construction as the system is fully assembled; factory tested and is dispatched to site ready for quick installation. The convenience of the pre-assembled system has enabled the PSP Alliance team to install, and commission the system without the need for repeat visits to site. The Mono SMART pressure sewer equipment is the only system available offering a complete dry pump well - with pump components not submerged in the sewage.
